For the past several years, St. Anne's has been actively preparing for the future. These preparations include expansion of youth-oriented and community outreach programs. St. Anne's is blessed with talented and driven parishioners dedicated to leading and growing meaningful programs for the youth of our congregation. We understand that a significant part of our future growth and member retention is based on providing youth-attractive spiritual training and social activities. Our on-going and expanding community outreach programs target the less privileged and underserved.
